

Care Instructions – Cotton/ Linen Cover Lido Lounger	Information and Care Instructions - Lido Lounger Frame and Footstool
<p>A high-quality half-linen fabric is used for the cover of the Lido lounger. This fabric is woven according to an old tradition, which can be recognised by the visible selvage. All weaving, finishing and making up, the yarn and the dyeing are carried out in Switzerland.</p> <p>To ensure that you enjoy this product for a long time, we recommend that you take note of the following care guidelines:</p> <p>The fabric, without the aluminium profiles, can be dry cleaned.</p> <p>If the aluminium profiles are removed, the fabric can be washed at 40 degrees in the washing machine. Only use mild detergents without brighteners and bleaching agents.</p> <p>Tip: Before washing the cover for the first time, soak it overnight in white vinegar water (half white wine vinegar, half water). This keeps the colours beautiful and allows the linen to swell.</p>	<p>The Lido lounger frame by Battista Guidici is made of galvanised steel.</p> <p>The artisanal process of galvanising is the best known corrosion protection for steel.</p> <p>During the bath in liquid zinc, both metals fuse on the surface of the workpiece to form an iron-zinc alloy layer. On top of this, a pure zinc layer is formed, which, depending on the process, can turn out irregularly and forms, under the influence of the weather, the characteristic zinc flower pattern. The furniture surface is enlivened by this process and blends into the landscape much more organically than stainless steel or aluminium.</p> <p>Galvanised frames can stand outdoors for many years without any protective measures.</p> <p>Dirt should be removed with warm soapy water and a brush.</p> <p>Since pure zinc is quite soft, avoid using objects that can cause scratches when cleaning!</p> <p>Please note that galvanising is sensitive to acid. Therefore, do not use any acidic cleaning agents.</p> <p>Make sure that leaf and fruit residues are removed from galvanised steel as soon as possible, as their acid content can irreparably damage the galvanisation.</p> <p>When used near the sea with salty air, the corrosion resistance of galvanised products is limited.</p> <p>If you follow these care instructions, you will enjoy the Lido lounger for many years.</p>
